This workshop covers:

- Heat distressing Kunin Felt with heatgun
- Burning with pyrography iron
- Changing a flat surface into a 3D form
- Embellishing the surface with stitch and beading



You will leave this workshop with a unique 3D bowl or vessel, with surface decoration in both stitch and beading.
